BAPTISM IN RUSSIAN CULTURE: WINTER RITUALS AND HOLY WATER

Every year on January 19, Orthodox Christians celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord – the day when Jesus Christ was baptized in the Jordan River. In Russia, this holiday is filled with winter atmosphere, folk traditions, and the mysticism of holy water.

Holy Water and Its Power

The main symbol of the holiday is blessed water. It is believed to cleanse the soul, heal illnesses, and protect the home. Many people collect holy water to bless their houses or drink a small amount in the morning for health.

Epiphany Ice Bathing

One of the most striking traditions is immersion in an ice hole. It is a test of courage and an act of faith in spiritual purification. After the dip, it's important to warm up with hot tea and warm clothes – the emotions last a long time!

Folk Beliefs

It is believed that those who immerse themselves on Epiphany night will stay healthy throughout the year. Even a small amount of holy water kept at home is thought to bring good luck and bright thoughts.

Today, Epiphany unites religious and folk traditions: some people go to church, some bravely plunge into icy water, and others preserve family customs. This January holiday remains a time of courage, purity, and winter magic.




TELL US A LITTLE ABOUT YOURSELF — WHERE ARE YOU FROM AND WHAT DO YOU ENJOY DOING IN YOUR FREE TIME?

I'm originally from the Ural region – a small, cozy town called Lysva in Perm Krai. I studied in Yekaterinburg, then lived 6 years in Moscow, 9 years in the United Arab Emirates, and the past 1.5 years in the United States. Who knows where life will take me next... By education, I'm a chemical engineer specializing in electrochemical coatings, and I've been working in the aviation industry for over 10 years. In my free time, I love dancing and traveling. During our years in the UAE, we explored much of Europe and Asia, and now I'm excited to discover America.

HOW DID YOUR FIRST ENCOUNTER WITH OUR GARDEN HAPPEN, AND WHAT WAS IT THAT CAPTURED YOUR HEART?

I was looking for new people, friends, and a community in my new country. Last summer, together with my neighbor, I accidentally attended an event at the Russian Garden – and it turned out to be a real revelation for me. I was incredibly struck by the feeling of being part of something big and meaningful. There were amazing people gathered here – vibrant, diverse, with active life positions and strong charisma. I simply couldn't leave. The atmosphere in the UAE was completely different: mostly centered around family life, whereas here, these are bold people who weren't afraid to leave the past behind and start everything anew. I think it's exactly this sense of community and inner freedom that I was searching for when I decided to emigrate.

WHAT INSPIRES YOU THE MOST IN OUR GARDEN?

I really resonate with the atmosphere of freedom here – you can be yourself and do what you truly enjoy, without judgment or constraints. I ended up as a rock granddaughter instead of a coquette – and that's perfectly fine. What's especially meaningful for me is that my daughter is always by my side. She is getting acquainted with the culture, fairy tales, and traditions, even though she has only been to Russia three times in her life. She genuinely enjoys participating in everything, and her curiosity and joy inspire me even more each time.

Anniversary: 250 Years Since the Signing of the United States Declaration of Independence

On July 4, 2026, America will celebrate a quarter millennium since the signing of the Declaration – a monumental milestone for the country and a reason for grand celebrations.

But for the garden to continue to bloom and grow, we need your support. **Support** that brings ideas to life, that allows music to play, flowers to flourish, and people to come together.




