What November Promises: Time-Tested Signs

November is a mirror of
winter: if the month is snowy,
the winter will be harsh; if

On Dmitriev Day (November 8), snow means a long winter.

If the ground was covered with snow on this day, people believed it wouldn't melt until spring. Dmitriev Day was considered the boundary between autumn and winter.

On Mikhailov Day (November 21), winter takes charge.

After this holiday, people expected the first real frosts. If it snowed on Mikhailov Day, blizzards would follow all winter; if it was calm and clear, the winter would be mild and steady.

If the stars shine brightly in November – expect frost; if they are dim – expect snow.

Our ancestors knew how to read the sky. By the night's starry glow, peasants could tell when to expect the first severe frost.
