# 79TH ONE WORLD DAY: A CELEBRATION OF CULTURES IN CLEVELAND





### WITH THE RUSSIAN CULTURAL GARDEN


On August 15, the Russian Cultural Garden hosted the third evening in our summer Open Air Movie Nights series.


